

Public Housing Rental

A rental programme for those on the Government's Public Housing register, to provide decent affordable and secure housing.

The Queenstown Lakes Community Housing Trust (QLCHT) is a registered Public Housing provider with the Ministry of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

The Public Housing Rental programme is for those on the national Public Housing register, providing a decent home, security of tenancy and subsidised rent.

Rents are set by HUD based on a household's income, typically around 25% of total household gross income.

The tenancy runs for five years, at which point you are encouraged to transition to the next housing programme, should you have the financial capacity to do so.



Public Housing Rental provides a decent home that is warm and dry.



Rents are affordable as they are set based on your household income.



Public Housing Rental provides a secure, five-year tenancy.

Five years of security and affordability.

Public Housing Rent is a five-year opportunity to worry less about housing and instead focus on health and wellbeing, finances, occupation and plan for the future.
